To sustainably manage forests, combat desertification, halt and reverse land degradation, and halt biodiversity loss



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## A. General Statistics

- i. Pakistan is rich in biodiversity, particularly in the arid and semi-arid regions which cover almost 80% of the total land area.<sup>1</sup>
- ii. A number of animal and plant species are threatened and/or endangered largely due to over-exploitation and loss of natural habitat.
- iii. The Government of Pakistan prepared the National Conservation Strategy (NCS) in 1992.
- iv. Forests in Pakistan cover an area of 4.224 million ha, covering only 4.8% of the total surveyed area of 87.98 million ha.<sup>2</sup>
- v. The Government of Pakistan has taken a number of steps for the protection and conservation of biodiversity including the national protected areas system.
- vi. From 2001 to 2012, Pakistan gained 850 ha of tree cover equal to < 0.1% of the global total.<sup>3</sup>
- vii. In Pakistan from 2001 to 2019, 15% of tree cover loss occurred in areas where the dominant drivers of loss resulted in deforestation.<sup>4</sup>
- viii. In Pakistan, the peak fire season typically begins in mid-January and lasts around 8 weeks. There were 1,327 VIIRS fire alerts reported between 16<sup>th</sup> of March 2020 and 8<sup>th</sup> of March 2021.<sup>5</sup>
