GOAL 17: PARTNERSHIPS FOR GOALS

A. General Statistics

Economic Survey of Pakistan (2019-2020)¹

- i. During FY 2019, the overall fiscal deficit increased to 9.1% of GDP.
- ii. Total revenues stood at 12.9% of GDP.
- iii. Non-tax revenues reduced to 1.1% of GDP.
- iv. Development expenditures and net lending reduced from 4.7% of GDP in FY 2018 to 3.2% of GDP in FY 2019.
- v. FBR tax collection has witnessed a remarkable turnaround during the current fiscal year after posting negative growth of 0.4% in FY 2019. The overall FBR tax collection grew by 10.8% to Rs. 3,300.6 billion during July-April, FY 2020 against Rs. 2,980.0 billion in the comparable period last year.
- vi. During FY 2019, total revenues of provinces grew by 2.0% to Rs. 2,995.9 billion against Rs. 2,938.5 billion in FY 2018.

Digital 2020: Pakistan, DATAREPORTAL²

- i. There were 76.38 million internet users in Pakistan in January 2020.
- ii. The number of internet users in Pakistan increased by 11 million (+17%) between 2019 and 2020.
- iii. Internet penetration in Pakistan stood at 35% in January 2020.
